To propose a Feature Topic with *Ex-position***, follow these instructions:** (updated May 2018)

- The proposal should consist of the title of the Feature Topic (FT) and a call for papers of 300-500 words, preferably including some suggested rubrics for prospective contributors. Please also include the names of at least four pre-invited contributors and the tentative title and a 100-word abstract of each article to be submitted. Prepare the document in Word format.
- Attach the CVs of the FT proposer(s) and all the pre-invited contributors along with the proposal.
- Submit the proposal to the editorial office at **<exposition@ntu.edu.tw>** at least **18 months** prior to the anticipated publication date. For example:
 - ◆ For the December 2019 issue, proposals should be sent in by June 30, 2018; for the June 2020 issue, proposals should be sent in by December 31, 2018.
- All proposals are to be reviewed by the editorial board and may be subject to revision upon suggestions of the board. If a FT is approved, the journal will announce the call for papers, and the proposers are strongly advised to solicit more submissions actively.
- The journal is under no obligation to publish the papers invited by the proposer(s). For quality control, all submissions will undergo the standard review process of the journal.
- Scholars interested in proposing a FT are encouraged to discuss their topics with the editor prior to making a proposal.
